



#### A READING FROM THE BOOK OF THE PROPHET ISAIAH


Is 2:1-5

# A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO LUKE

Lk 23:35-43

R/Glory to you, O Lord

The rulers sneered at Jesus and said, "He saved others, let him save himself if he is the chosen one, the Christ of God."

Even the soldiers jeered at him. As they approached to offer him wine they called out, "If you are King of the Jews, save yourself."

Above him there was an inscription that read, "This is the King of the Jews."

**Assembly:** May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands for the praise and glory of his name, for our good and the good of all his holy Church.





#### **ACT OF SPIRITUAL COMMUNION:**




