

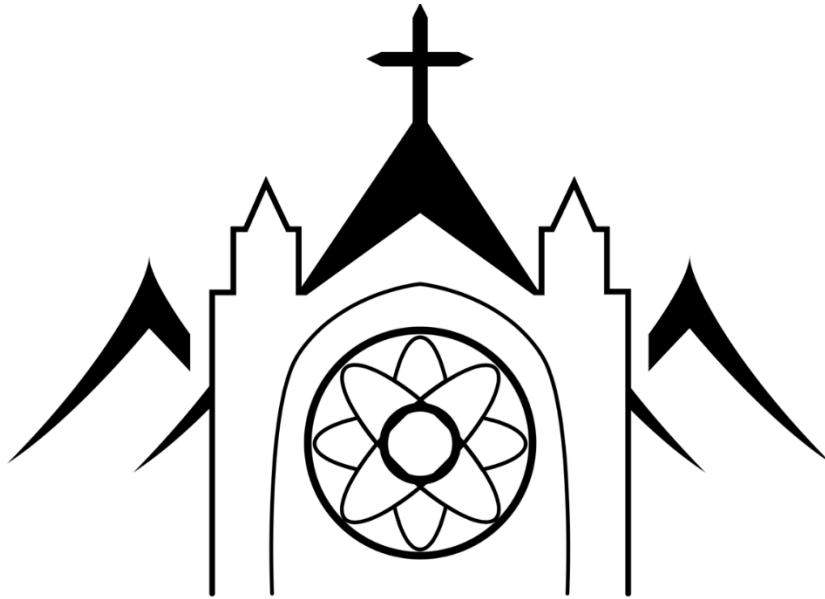



## NICENE CREED

**I** believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.

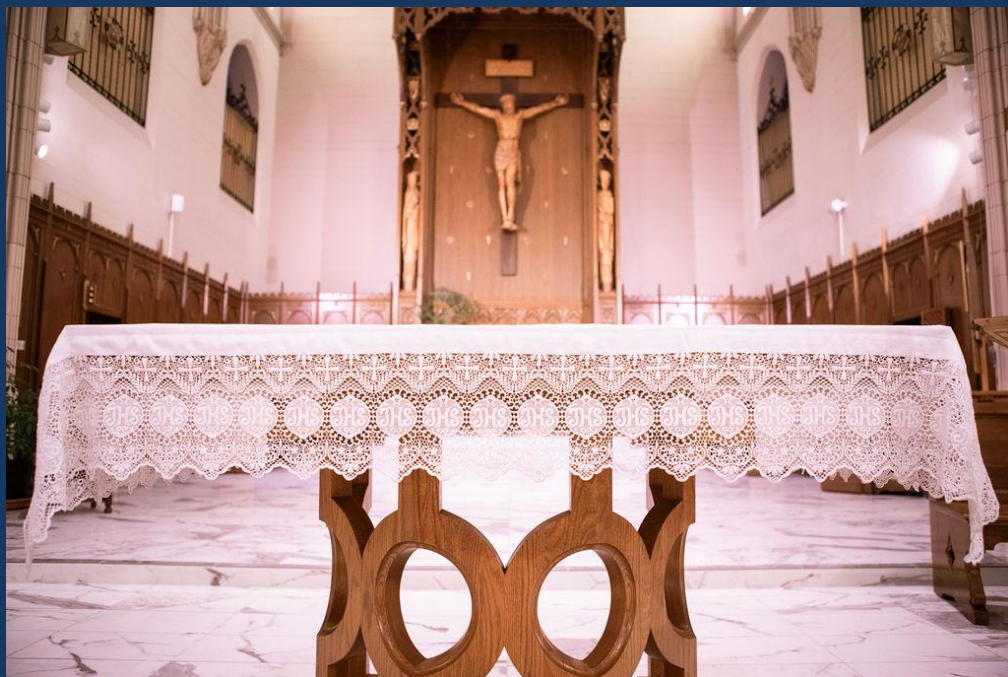





### ACT OF SPIRITUAL COMMUNION:


