

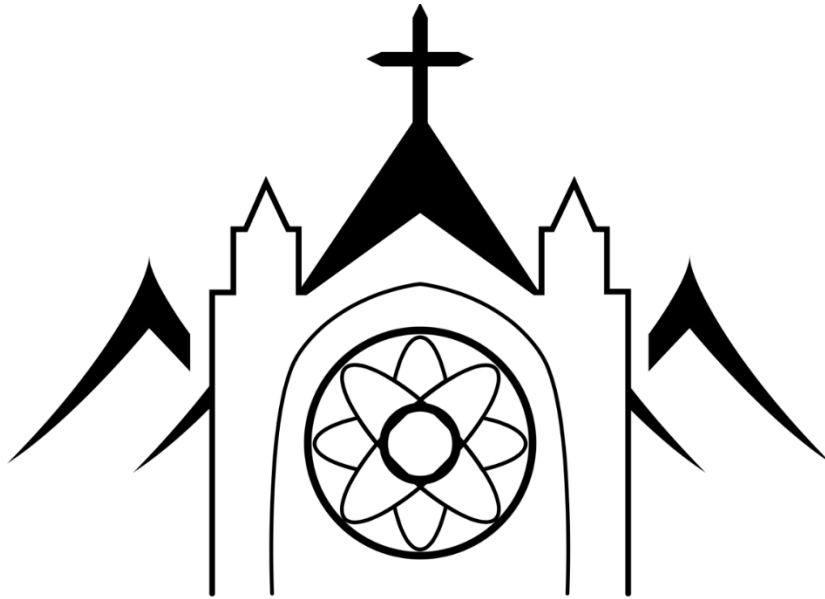

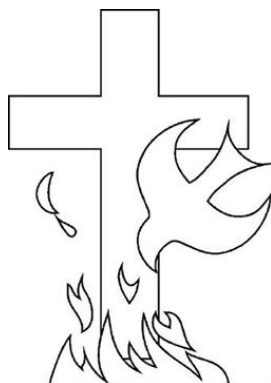

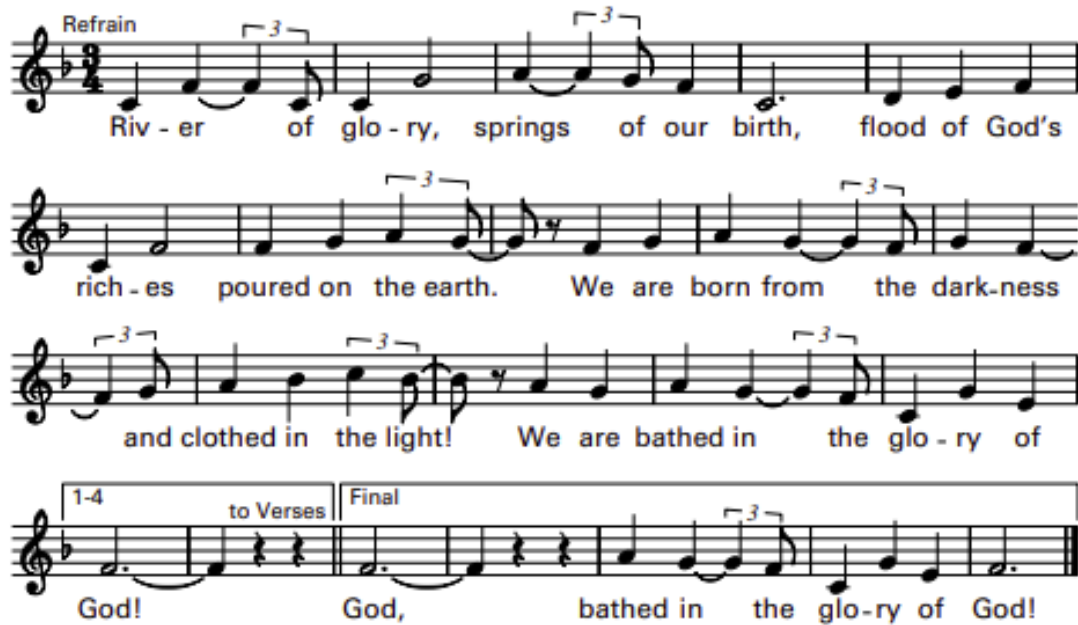

READING FROM THE ACTS OF THE APOSTLES *Acts 2:1-11*

When the time for Pentecost was fulfilled,
they were all in one place together.

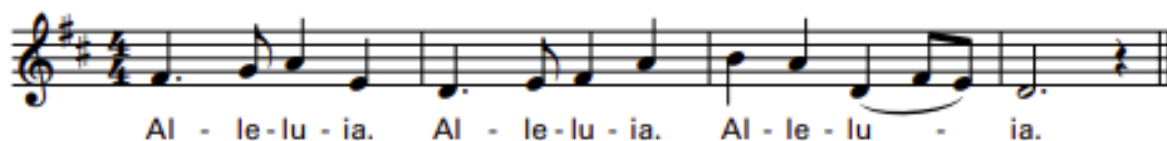

NICENE CREED
